

REQUIRED CERTIFICATIONS FOR LONG-TERM RENTAL PERMIT

If more than one option is provided for (as indicated by a ☐, select the appropriate box which applies (only one option should be selected):

- a. To the best of my/our knowledge, the dwelling unit that is the subject of the rental permit application (the "rental unit") is safe and fit for human habitation.
- b. Electrical systems in the rental unit are serviceable with no visual defects or unsafe conditions.
- c. All fireplaces, fireplace inserts or other fuel burning heaters and furnaces located at the rental property are vented and properly installed and flues have been cleaned within the preceding twelve (12) month period.
- d. The use of the rental unit as a rental will comply with all requirements of Chapter 103 including the requirements set forth in Section 103-17.
- e. I have read a copy of the most recently enacted version of Chapter 103 (Rental Properties) of the Code of the Village of Greenport and the New York State Property Maintenance Code and agree to abide by the same.
- f. I do not have any knowledge of any complaints from tenants or others regarding any existing code, safety or health violations at the property which is the subject of the rental permit application.
- g. To the best of my knowledge all of the information, documentation and certifications delivered and/or made in connection with the rental permit application in respect of the rental unit are true and correct in all material respects.
