2 MAYOR STUESSI: I would like
3 to make a motion to open the Annual
4 Organization Meeting of April 23,
5 2026.

6 DEPUTY MAYOR BRENNAN: Second.

7 MAYOR STUESSI: All the favor?

8 (ALL AYES.)

9 MAYOR STUESSI: Please stand
10 for the Pledge of Allegiance.

11 (Whereupon, the Pledge of
12 Allegiance was recited.)

13 MAYOR STUESSI: Please be
14 seated.

15 Good evening, everybody. I
16 want to thank the Board, the Village
17 clerk, and the public for being here
18 this evening, and for those of you
19 who might be watching or listening
20 now, or at a later point.

21 We are obviously in some very
22 challenging economic times with the
23 cost of all matter of goods
24 continuing to go up on a regular
25 basis. Our board had very thoughtful

2 conversations as it relates to the
3 budget, and there's a very small
4 increase relative to many of the
5 things that we are facing due to
6 larger pressures.

7 In addition to that, many
8 folks had made comment in regards to
9 utility costs, and I will remind the
10 public; the Village has the great
11 benefit of being part of the New York
12 Power Association, and gets our power
13 through Niagara Falls, as opposed to
14 dealing with LIPA and PSEG, as
15 everyone else on Long Island, except
16 in two other communities.

17 That said, the winter
18 challenges of significant snowfall,
19 and in certain cases, houses weren't
20 able to be checked for meters because
21 the crew who does all of our meter
22 checks couldn't get to them. And so,
23 the Village estimated power usage
24 based off the trailing 12 months.

25 Adam Brautigam, our Village

2 Treasurer, has spoken on this in a
3 recent few meetings. In addition I
4 appreciate Trustee Lily, from the
5 Communications Committee, who sent
6 out a special e-mail notice to
7 everybody who is on that list --
8 which is quite significant; if there
9 is anybody who is not on there, I
10 would encourage you to get on this
11 list -- explaining this, and what the
12 true op is. That said, if there is
13 any true emergency situations; maybe
14 some financial challenges for
15 somebody, the Village does offer a
16 limited payment program that has been
17 approved by our board that the
18 Village Treasurer implements. He can
19 provide any details on that.

20 With that, we are going to be
21 moving forward with motions, and
22 appointments for the upcoming year.

23 I also want to recognize that
24 this is the final year of this
25 administration. There are three of

2 us up here on the dais, who were
3 elected three years ago for a
4 four-year term, and we are in the
5 last year of our term, and two other
6 board members who were elected just a
7 year ago. As I had shared with the
8 public long ago, I had intended to
9 run, or serve for one term. I ran
10 for one term, and served for one
11 term, and I am absolutely sticking
12 with that. But I really enjoyed my
13 service to the community, and looking
14 forward to closing out this year --
15 the last one of this term of this
16 administration -- with some really
17 wonderful things for the community,
18 and getting through a number of
19 projects, and bringing further good
20 to the community.

21 With that, the agenda is as
22 follows. We have meeting motions and

22 The last thing I want to add
23 for the public before we get into
24 this, is to thank everybody who
25 serves this Village; not just those

2 who are elected, but the incredible
3 crew of folks who work for the
4 Village, from the Village Clerk, to
5 our Treasurer, the staff who cleans
6 up the trash, makes road repairs,
7 picks up brush, the electric
8 department, sewer department. We
9 have a big team, and they all come in
10 and work very hard for the community,
11 and that is enormously important.

12 I also want to thank all of
13 our volunteers in the community. We
14 have had a very significant and
15 engaged community, many who serve on
16 Village committees; Statutory
17 committees, such as Planning and ZBA,
18 which requires a good amount of
19 expertise, diligence, thoughtful
20 conversation in reviewing
21 applications before both of those
22 boards. And then others who have
23 done some really wonderful work for
24 the community on anything from HPC to
25 the Mini Railroad Committee, to many

11 some volunteers for the Carousel
12 Committee. We are looking for one
13 more person for the Mini Train
14 Committee.

15 With that, I'm going to move
